Requirements for Minor in Africana Studies

The minor in Africana Studies is intended for students interested in exploring aspects of the Black Experience in ways that relate to their own major fields of study. The sequence of lower and upper division courses gives the student a well balanced analysis of the varied aspects of the African and African-American experience. All courses offered for the minor, except for those graded S/U, must be passed with a letter grade of C or higher.

AFS minors must complete 21 credits or 7 three-credit courses passed with a grade C or higher. Four of these courses must be at the 300 to 400 level. The major and minor cannot be selected from the same academic department.
