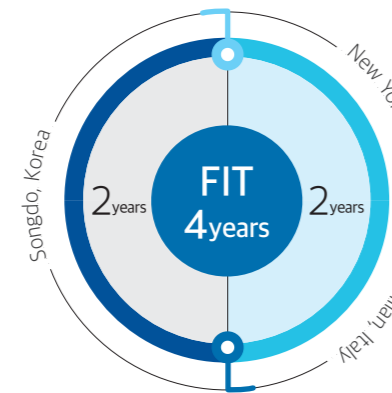

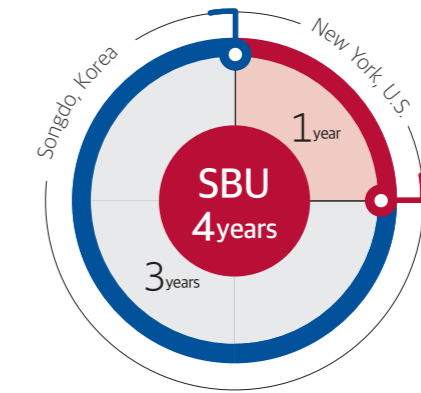

Applied Mathematics and Statistics

A study of how to cope with problems and solve those problems by mathematical skills in the fields of systems, management, engineering, accounting, and statistics.

Mechanical Engineering

A pivotal major for engineering which requires interest and capability in physics, science, and mathematics, as well as an ability to apply those studies to social needs.

Technological Systems Management

 - Personal Statement (ENG) : Less than 650 words, online submission
 - High School Transcript (ENG)
 - Students that graduated high schools in the U.S. are recommended to submit SAT or ACT test scores
 - College/University official transcript is required for those who have enrolled in college/university
 - Recommendation letter (ENG or KOR)
 - Must be processed through online application (Full name and email address of the recommender is required)
 - English proficiency test score
 - Must be submitted to SUNY Korea via testing institutions
 - Applicants without English proficiency test score may apply for Provisional Admissions
